INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS RESEARCH APPLICATION DEADLINE: 18 SEPTEMBER 17:00

International Business Research is a student run project of the EBF and the University of Groningen. This year's destinations of the International Business Research project are Malaysia & Vietnam. During this 10 week long international consultancy project, you will conduct market research abroad for a company. The preparation phase starts in November, in which you will prepare the research. During your stay abroad (April-June), you will conduct the field research for a period of five weeks. After this, you have the chance to explore the country by travelling in small groups for another five weeks! Besides being a great boost for your CV, joining IBR is an unforgettable experience!

EUROPEAN STUDY RESEARCH FALL 22 - 30 NOVEMBER - ONLY OPEN FOR MASTER STUDENTS

The European Study Research (ESR) is a one week-long research trip. This trip is an unique experience for you to broaden and diversify your skill set, to improve your research abilities and to create memories and friendships. For this trip 25 students will join the ESR Committee to a European destination and visit several companies to find answers on their research questions. Before the actual trip, you will have lectures, dinners and socials to prepare your research. Former destinations have been for example Barcelona, Rome and Lisbon.


EBF MEMBERSHIP VALUE CARD

Why can pre-master students not apply for the September committee recruitment and the ESR Fall participation? We noticed that study and a committee or ESR participation are difficult to combine for pre-master students in the first semester. Does every master have its own EBF Master Community? For masters that are not served by a subassociation, the EBF offers an EBF Master Community. See page 12! Q: Can I become an active member in my Master Community? Q: Are the EBF Events open to international students? The large majority of our events are completely in English, and are, therefore, open to international students. The language of the events are always indicated in the event description on our Facebook page.
